### **Addendum to Statement of Interest for the Green Meadow School**

As a result of significant and pressing facilities problems, the Maynard School Committee was forced to take action. This spring at our May Town Meeting and in a following debt-exclusion override vote in June, the community voted to initiate these facilities projects for the 07-08 school year. All have been referenced in more detail in our original Green Meadow Statement of Interest.

- Boiler Replacements / Conversion to Gas - \$280,000
- Oil Tank Removal - \$22,000
- Roof Repair - \$50,000
- Unit Ventilator Replacement - \$156,000
- Exhaust Fan Replacement - \$85,000
- Kitchen Exhaust Hood - \$8,200

As of this writing a boiler has failed and will not be repaired due to its 40+ year age and condition. We anticipate substantial energy savings by moving to natural gas. The roof repairs are an immediate necessity. The ventilation concerns are a health and safety concerns, however these monies will not address all the HVAC issues. The kitchen exhaust hood is a fire safety issue.

Finally, you should be aware that the Maynard School Committee has initiated a Facilities Committee and charged the committee with developing short-term planning as well as developing long-term renovation/rebuilding options. In conclusion the School District seeks any and all potential MSBA reimbursement for these necessary renovations.
