129 Parker Street

District Wellness Policy

Dr. Mayer is working on the District's new Wellness Policy. The policy addresses food, health education, and physical fitness education in an attempt to combat the national obesity and Type II diabetes crisis. It is also designed to meet the Federal mandate for all districts to adopt such a policy this summer. In the next school year a building-based comprehensive school health committee will focus on helping ensure the smooth implementation of this policy and improvement of the nutrition environments at all schools.

WAVM Update

Mark Minasian has been appointed the new WAVM Director and presented to the Committee his view of improvements for the 2006/2007 broadcast season including: preparing for the increase in power to 500 watts; promotion of the station and the school through radio and television commercials; conducting a survey of radio listeners and television viewers to see what they would like to have on air; expanded television coverage of school events; training program that runs through the year; continued evening parent supervision and returning to a diverse radio programming format.
