Gift Giving to Students

In the effort to encourage and motivate academic success and achievement, faculty and staff members of the Maynard Public School may choose to recognize such success or achievement with a gift, award, or some other appropriate action for a student.

Such gifts will be limited to a cumulative fair market of \$200 per student per Fiscal Year.

If a Maynard Public School employee sells or rents an item to a student or student's family at below fair market value, the difference shall be considered a gift.

Any gift that has a fair market value of more than \$20 shall be reported by the employee to the building principal in writing, prior to the presentation of the gift.

Gifts by Maynard Public School employees to students who are relatives, godchildren or the equivalent of the employee or the employee's spouse are exempt from this restriction.

Contributions to a school or community sponsored fund-raising for a student or student's family are exempt from this restriction.
